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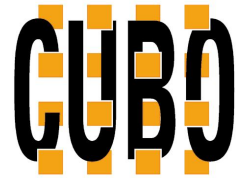
Giorgio Anania joins the Board of Directors of Cube Optics AG

He has an MA from Oxford University in Physics and a PhD from Princeton University in Thermonuclear Fusion.
